Fees are based on income, and you must show proof of income to qualify.

Spay Day dates are set by the veterinarian twice a month always on Wednesdays.

All surgeries are by appointment only. Cost is \$45.00 & includes spay/neuter, FVRCP & a rabies vaccination.

If the pet is already vaccinated the surgery is \$25.00 but you MUST bring proof of vaccinations with you at drop off.

Drop off times for surgery are between 8:30am & 10am. The cat MUST be in a carrier! Pick up times are between 6pm & 7:30pm.

The night before surgery the cat gets no food after 6pm and no water after midnight.

We can schedule 50 cats per Spay Day- make your appointment asap!

To participate in Animal Friends' LCSN program, you must:

1. Live in southwestern Pennsylvania
2. Click here to fill out your application. You must submit one application per pet.
3. Be prepared to provide proof of income for all adults living within the household.

Proof of income can be a paycheck stub, W-2 form, proof of Social Security or disability benefits, proof of unemployment or workmen's compensation, or proof of Medicare or Medicaid. Your information remains confidential.

4. Animal Friends will call you to schedule an appointment.
